TEACHING

Undergraduate

REN 441: Markets, Trade and Natural Resources. This course provides an overview of the economics, markets, regulation, institutional structure, and operation of the seafood, and natural resource sectors. Emphasis is placed on how international trade, development, food security, energy and natural resource policy, pricing systems (such as futures and options markets), and ecolabeling will likely influence efficient and sustainable natural resource use.

REN 435: Aquacultural Economics. This course covers global and domestic trends in aquaculture development, interaction between aquaculture and traditional fisheries, use conflicts in the coastal zone, ecosystem interactions, policy and regulatory issues, and firm-level decision making.

Graduate

REN 502: Research Methodology in Applied Environmental & Natural Resource Economics. This course introduces students to the practice and methods of applied research in environmental and natural resource economics. Topics include philosophical foundations, the role of economic research in public decision making, research project design, reporting technical research results, and constructive criticism of proposals and research papers. Much of this course will involve examining and discussing successful proposals and high-quality published research.

REN 525: Dynamic Economic Models. This course explores the use of control theory and other dynamic methods to evaluate problems in natural resource management and economics. One-half of the course focuses on technical aspects of solving dynamic problems, and half focuses on application to resource issues, such as: optimal renewable resource management, non-renewable resource extraction, ecosystem simulation, policy analysis, and environmental regulation.

REN 545: Natural Resource Markets and Trade. This course covers the use of theoretical and empirical approaches to evaluate the influence of the market on natural resource use, environmental practices, and international development. Topics include: price determination mechanisms and dynamics in natural resource prices, futures markets, international fisheries (and other resources) trade, trade barriers, the relationship between developed and developing nations, sustainable natural resource use, the role of cooperatives, and other institutions.

REN 610: Environmental Damage Assessment. This team-taught course focuses on the regulations associated with environmental damages and the process by which environmental damages are determined. The core of this course centers on detailed evaluation of damage determination in the *Exxon Valdez* oil spill case, including specific documents and testimony from the trial.
