

### U.S. Unemployment Rate, Official Unemployment Rate and More Expansive **Alternative Measure of Unemployment, Seasonally Adjusted**




<sup>—</sup>U-3, total unemployed, as a percent of the civilian labor force (official unemployment rate)




# New Business Applications and Formations in the United States, Seasonally Adjusted






## Top H-2A States, 2022 Certified Positions and Change in Positions from Fiscal Year 2021 to Fiscal Year 2022






# Certified H-2A Positions by Fiscal Year and Calendar Year U.S. Average AEWR







#### U.S. AEWR, 2009-2023

### Percentage Increase in 2023 AEWR Over 2022 AEWR



#### **Dollar Increase in 2023 AEWR Over 2022 AEWR**





## PRIORITY: Border Security



#### **REGULATORY CHALLENGES**

- USCIS Fee Increases (comments due March 13<sup>th</sup>)
  - 137% increase; limited to 25 per petition; \$600 asylum fee
- Final H-2A wage rule released Monday
  - Disaggregated, higher wage rates for certain job occupations
  - Will raise labor costs beyond normal annual AEWR increases
- OSHA currently in rulemaking for federal heat standard
  - Proposed rule expected in May
  - Action plan when temp reaches or exceeds 80 degrees

## **AFBF Policy**

 12 pages (!), covering visa reform, OSHA standards, general immigration and labor issues

• "We support an uncapped agricultural worker visa program that is open to all segments of agriculture and flexible enough to provide for the differing needs of farmers and ranchers." (137.1.5)

 "We support permitting experienced visa and undocumented agricultural workers who are employed in agriculture prior to bill introduction the opportunity to earn permanent legal status..." (137.1.9.3)
